Since our last regular meeting, Staff have completed preparations for the annual meeting and have notified selected companies for the annual compliance review. Staff have assisted companies with outstanding remittances and corrections.

A copy of the May 2025 financial report is included this month, labelled VI.A. This month the Board has one item to consider, the approval of the invoice for administrative services from AECA for the month of May 2025.

Receipt of the invoice for the 2024 financial audit services is expected in July. AUSAC issued an RFP in July 2024 for the 2024 financial audit services with an option to extend the bid award for two additional years. The AUSAC Board selected a one year bid from Alban for the 2024 services and Alban indicated that they were not interested in additional extensions as their workforce has retirement plans. Board review of prior bids is included under the executive session agenda item.

In July, AUSAC will be issuing an RFP for the compliance review of 2024 to be performed in 2026. The Board will review bids in September.
