II. Approval of Agenda

IV. Approval of Prior Minutes

V. AUSF Remittance and Distribution Report

Board President Andilea Weaver asked Ms. Bernier to present the January 2021 AUSF Remittance and Distribution Report. She proceeded to lead a review of the current disbursements and provided a review of the historical yearly disbursements and remittances noting that the reported revenues in 2020 were \$14,424,848 and in 2019 they were \$51,858,521.

The last portion of the credits for company #4291 were applied this period and DEM support is no longer an approved support item as of January 2021.

Ms. Bernier continued with a review of the support shortage and estimated that a portion of the September period shortage will be dropped due to the 6 month drop off timeframe.

The support funds are scheduled to be distributed on February 26, 2021. A copy of the distribution report was included in the packet labeled V.

Motion, by Juliana Wayman, seconded by Larry Snipes, that the Board approves the January 2021 AUSF Remittance and Distribution Report and authorizes the distribution of funds on or about February 26, 2021 in the amount of \$1,098,484.11.

Motion passed, unopposed.

VI. Agent Report

Board President Andilea Weaver asked Ms. Bernier to present the monthly administrative report, along with the financial reports for January. Ms. Bernier provided a copy of the January report and is included in these minutes.

There is one item for the Board to consider, the invoice from AECA for January 2021 administrative services.

BOARD ACTION REQUEST #1:

Motion, by Bob Dunn, seconded by Lisa Phillips that the Board approves the payment for invoice number 308, from AECA, for January 2021 administrative services for a total of \$4,739.39.

Motion passed, unopposed.

VII. Unfinished Business

A. Midcourse 2021 Surcharge Calculation

Ms. Bernier provided a brief review of the midcourse 2021 surcharge calculation in response to a company implementing billing system changes. The Board reviewed the draft filing and made edits to the cover letter.

Motion, by Lisa Phillips, seconded by Steve Kramer that the Board approves the draft TA 35-998 filing as edited.

Motion passed, unopposed.

B. Status – U-21-002(1)

The U-21-002(1) was provided as information. The director nominees have been approved and the docket has been closed.

C. AUSAC Financial Audit – 2020

Ms. Bernier provided a brief review of the 2020 financial audit process where Alban has been engaged for an additional year. The Alban bid is \$100 over the amount in the approved 2021 AUSAC budget but there are sufficient funds in the budget under director and committee expenses to cover the \$100.

Motion, by Lisa Phillips, seconded by Bob Dunn that the Board accepts the bid from Alban for \$10,800 for the 2020 financial audit.

Motion passed, unopposed.

D. AUSF Compliance Review – 2019

Ms. Bernier provided a brief review of the compliance review bid process where AUSAC has extended the engagement with Erickson & Brooks for an additional year. The bid amount per company is \$1,950 and there are sufficient funds budgeted for the compliance audit.

Motion, by Steve Kramer, seconded by Juliana Wayman that the Board accepts the bid from Erickson & Brooks for reviewing the 2019 period for the amount of \$1,950 per company.

Motion passed, unopposed.

VII. Unfinished Business

E. AUSF Adjustment Time Frame

Ms. Bernier provided a brief review of the prior discussion on the AUSF remittance adjustment time frame and reviewed the documents labeled VII.E in the meeting packet. The Board discussed the impacts a shortened adjustment window will have on the fund and that the compliance review timeframe is exempt from the company submitted remittance adjustment time frame.

Ms. Bernier notified the Board that AUSAC has received a remittance credit estimate from a company that will be submitting adjustments for most of the 2020 year due to an over-reporting error for promotional discounts and safe harbor. The adjustment is estimated at \$15,000 and is recommended to be taken over 4 months.

Motion, by Steve Kramer, seconded by Shawn Uschmann that the Board approves the issuance of the credit to the revising company over four months.

Motion passed, unopposed.

Motion, by Bob Dunn, seconded by Steve Kramer that the Board approve the change to the AUSAC Remittance Worksheet Instructions to change the language "Revision period is the most recent 24 months" to "Revision period is the most recent 6 months."

Motion passed, unopposed.

F. AUSF Sunset Review

There is nothing new this month on the AUSF sunset review. Lisa Phillips asked if AUSAC has received additional questions from RCA Staff. Ms. Bernier replied that the RCA Staff has not contacted her recently regarding the sunset, however, companies receiving support from the fund have been asking questions about where ENS came from, how does the AUSAC funding work and general background information on the AUSF support.

The March period distribution experienced a shortage of 100% after admin fees, see page 6. This month, 59.26% of the September 2020 period support will be disbursed, the remaining \$793,156.71 will exceed the six-month accrual and not be paid next month. The prior year shortage periods can be found in the prior year section starting on page 13 of this report. October 2020 through February 2021 periods continue to have a 100% shortage.
