V. AUSF Remittance and Distribution Report

Board President Juliana Wayman asked Ms. Bernier to present the May 2024 AUSF Remittance and Distribution Report.

Ms. Bernier proceeded to lead a brief review of the current disbursements and the distribution shortage. She noted that reported revenues for two large companies have been significantly fluctuating and that the companies have not responded to AUSAC's verification of reported revenues.

The support funds are scheduled to be distributed on June 28. 2024. A copy of the distribution report was included in the packet labeled V.

Motion, by Dave Collier, seconded by Lisa Koker, that the Board approves the May 2024 AUSF Remittance and Distribution Report and authorizes the distribution of funds on or about June 28, 2024 in the amount of \$1,011,442.30.

AGENT'S REPORT BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

July 26, 2024

Since our last regular meeting, Staff have provided Erickson & Brooks with data from all of the selected companies for the compliance review of 2022 and completed the review of the 2023 990 tax form. Additionally, Staff continue the preparation work for the remote office transition and continue to work with companies with outstanding miscellaneous reporting issues.

Business documents continue to be updated for the AUSAC address change to a PO Box and related tariff updates have been prepared. Staff continue to work through the record retention policy to clear out electronic and paper files that fall outside of the retention period. The project to move our internal remittance database to the cloud kicked off this week and is expected to be complete before the end of August.

The financial audit RFP was issued earlier this month and AUSAC has received responses from a few firms indicating their interest in bidding. Bids are due by the close of business on August 30, 2024.

A copy of the June 2024 financial report is included this month, labelled VI.A. This month the Board has two items to consider, the approval of the invoice for administrative services from AECA for the month of June and the payment of the invoice from Alban & Co. for the 2023 financial audit and 990 tax filing services. The Alban & Co. invoice is for the full approved bid amount and no additional invoices are expected.

BOARD ACTION REQUEST #1:

Recommend the Board approve the payment for invoice number 349 from AECA, for June 2024 administrative services for a total of \$4,301.94.

BOARD ACTION REQUEST #2:

Recommend the Board approve the payment of the invoice, from Alban & Co., for the 2023 financial audit and 990 tax filing services in the amount of \$10,700.

ALASKA TELECOM ASSOCIATION'S REQUEST TO EXTEND COMMENT PERIOD

Alaska Telecom Association ("ATA")¹ requests that the current comment period in this docket be extended by 90 days until October 28, 2024² in order to provide additional time for ATA members and the public to develop comments and proposed regulation amendments that will incorporate and address any statutory changes resulting from HB 307. HB 307 was transmitted to the Governor on July 16, 2024, and as of the date of this filing, has not yet been acted upon by the Governor (who has until August 8, 2024 to act).³ An extension will also provide ATA members and the public time to address any relevant analysis in any HB 307 bill review letter that is issued by the Department of Law.

DISCUSSION

On April 12, 2024, the Regulatory Commission Commission of Alaska ("Commission") issued Order R-24-001(1), opening this rulemaking docket to "reconsider revisions to our regulations in conformance with Chapter 24, SLA 19 [also known as "SB 83"]."⁴ The Commission had earlier adopted regulation amendments to implement SB 83 in Docket R-19-002, but those amendments were disapproved by the Department of Law ("DOL").⁵ The Commission noted in Order R-24-001(1) that Docket R-19-002 included "multiple rounds of public comment and a technical conference with interested persons."⁶ The Commission noted that the DOL Disapproval Memorandum stated that "we lack the authority to implement many of the regulations that we voted to adopt."⁷ The Commission issued proposed regulation amendments for public notice in this docket on April 12, 2024 ("Proposed Regulations").⁸

On July 16, 2024, the Legislature transmitted HB 307 to the Governor. HB 307 would add new subsection (g) to AS 42.05.141:

(g) Nothing in this chapter limits the authority of the commission under this section or AS 42.05.151 necessary to implement provisions that remain applicable under AS 42.05.321(b) or 42.05.711.9

The Governor has until August 8, 2024 to sign HB 307, veto the bill, or let it become law without

his signature. If the bill is signed, or becomes law without signature, the bill's effective date will

be the day after it is signed, or the day after the period to sign lapses.¹⁰

If HB 307 becomes law, the Proposed Regulations package and portions of the DOL

Disapproval Memorandum may no longer be appropriate or applicable. However, because the

Governor might not act on HB 307 until August 8, 2024, and the current comment period ends

July 29, 2024, additional time is required to allow commentors to provide thorough, constructive

comments—particularly comments that include proposed alternative regulation amendments in

light of any statutory changes. Accordingly, ATA requests that the Commission extend the

comment period by 90 days.

CONCLUSION

ATA respectfully requests that the Commission extend the public comment period in this

docket by 90 days until October 28, 2024. ATA has emailed a copy of this request to all recipients

of the Commission's April 12, 2024, e-mail issuing Order R-24-001(1).
